PRINCIPAL'S ADDRESS

The lecture was on the topic 'From budget to Current Development in India: Challenges and Opportunities'. Prof. Ram Singh threw light on the reasons behind the economic slowdown in India and suggested measures that must be taken by the government to address the same. The lecture helped the students gain a deeper insight into the changing dynamics of the Indian economy.

EVENT 2: ECO BUZZ (Annual fest)

The Economics Society of Shaheed Bhagat Singh Evening College successfully conducted an annual intra-college fest ECOBUZZ on September 27, 2019 comprising of two events. Firstly an event named 'Stratagem' was organized which was a competition designed to challenge the minds of the students, encourage them to create an original idea, formulate economic policies and deal in real time with economic situations that policy makers often face. Each team represented a model state of the country and had to deal with an economic situation/crisis assuming the role of the leader of their respective states. Disaster Management Seminar:

Due to pollution and negative human intervention, the number of disasters are increasing rapidly every year. This promising seminar on Disaster Management took place through a collaboration between N.S.S. and Department of Geography on 23rd September 2019. It enlightened the students' knowledge regarding how to protect, act and rescue when a disaster knocks. Second year batch of section 'A' went for a field survey trip to Chamba, Dalhousie and Khajjiar from 4th - 8th March 2020 under the supervision of Dr. Ravi Shekher. The students studied the socio-economic status of the area.

Shristi-2019-20:

Shristi is the propitious fest of the Geography department. Keeping with the tradition of annual Geography fest, this year too it was conducted on 22nd February 2020. The event started with a welcome address by the Principal and the Teacher-in-charge Dr. Anupama M Hasija, followed by a talk by Dr . V.S. Negi. During the year, more than **65 students** of SBSEC were successfully able to secure on campus placement. For this session, the average package offered to our college by various prestigious companies at the time of placement stood at Rs. 4,10,553.00 p.a.. The highest package for which our students got placed so far was Rs. 10.0 lakhs p.a.. The highest package that was offered by the D. E. Shaw Group stood at Rs. 20,00,000.00 p.a., and the placement drive for the same is in process. Due to the sudden outbreak of the Corona Virus Pandemic, around 10 campus placement drives were abandoned/delayed namely Grant Thornton, EY GDS (Off Campus), Art House Ltd, etc.

The Placement Cell was also successful in providing Internship offers to the students from different courses and years in the academic session 2019-20. Some of the prominent names were: Aditya Birla Capital Ltd., E&Y, Reliance Jio, Advantage Club, Coolberg, Mazars, MergerDomo, Grant Thornton, Ladli Foundation. During the year, more than 50 students were able to secure internships via the Placement Cell. The average stipend of the year 2019-20 stood at Rs. 4000.00 p.m. whereas the highest stipend that was offered stood at Rs. 12,000.00 p.m.
