The scheme aims to provide research opportunities to students enrolled in the fourth year of the undergraduate programme and to nurture their research aptitude, critical thinking, and academic potential.

For the Academic Session 2026-27, the broad theme for the Call for Research Proposals under ICSSR-YSPS is: **"Youth and Decolonisation"**

Students are encouraged to apply for this prestigious scheme and undertake research projects that contribute to the development of sound research skills and academic excellence.

The identified themes for research studies are as follows:

1. Decolonising Narratives: Indo-Aryan Theories
2. Decolonising Education and Research Methodology: Beyond Macaulay
3. Decolonising History, Culture and Language
4. Health and Mental Wellbeing
5. Economic and Financial Sovereignty
6. Decolonising Finance, Trade and Commerce
7. Decolonising Governance, Law and Political Thought
8. Rural Development, Environment and Indian Knowledge Systems

Students may also develop research proposals on any other relevant sub-theme that aligns with the broader theme of **Youth and Decolonisation**.

For the preparation and submission of research proposals, students may approach any faculty member of the College holding a Ph.D. degree whose area of research expertise aligns with the proposed theme. Such faculty members may act as **Project Directors** and guide students in the development of research proposals and completion of the application process.
